Reverse 9-1-1 System

In order to rapidly and effectively communicate emergency broadcasts or communications to the residents of Rockaway Township, the Police Department and the Office of Emergency Management for the Township utilize a reverse 9-1-1 system. This system utilizes the Verizon database for land line phones, not wireless, for the residents of Rockaway Township.

In today's times many people have their home phone service through other vendors instead of Verizon. Some residents only utilize cell phones for all of their phone needs. Unfortunately there have been times where the Township has utilized the reverse 9-1-1 system and not all of the targeted area has received calls due to the above reasons. Until now, that was the limitation of the system being used.

Effective now, any resident not using Verizon for their home phone number may go to the link below and register a phone number you wish to have included in the reverse 9-1-1 database for Rockaway Township. The link is user friendly and easy to understand the instructions to get you registered. If you utilize this link you will create a user name and password that will allow you to modify the information you enter in the future if the need arises. If you decide you no longer wish to be part of the reverse 9-1-1 database, it will be up to you to remove your number from the database in the future.

By using the link below and registering your non-verizon land based number, you will now be included with any future Reverse 9-1-1 notifications that go out to our residents. Our goal is to quickly and effectively communicate emergencies to our residents and to be sure that we reach every resident possible.
